The EAGLE Workshop entitled "Exploring Synergies Between Intergenerational, Intercultural and Later Life (e-)Learning" was held on 13 June, Friday discussing the synergies of inter-generational, intercultural and lifelong learning. Reflections on embedding intergenerational learning and its practices to vocational education, and the importance of intercultural elements in intergenerational learning in the light of the social changes in Europe were discussed.
